

COMMISSIONERS' ORDINANCE NO. O-15-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32.022 OF THE COVINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, PARKING AUTHORITY POWERS AND MANAGEMENT, TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE PARKING AUTHORITY SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON, KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

Section 32.022 of the Covington Code of Ordinances is amended to read as


follows:

**§ 32.022 POWERS AND MANAGEMENT.**

- (A) The Parking Authority shall have the power of acquisition, incurring of debt, creation and operation of public street and off-street parking facilities. The city is the current owner of various public street and off-street parking facilities, for which the Parking Authority, upon establishment, may negotiate to purchase and/or lease for its use. The Parking Authority and the city shall also establish a maintenance agreement regarding the maintenance of public and/or off-street parking facilities.
- (B) The City Manager or his or her designee shall be the Executive Director of the Parking Authority [~~and shall serve the Parking Authority without any compensation~~]. **The compensation of the Executive Director shall be established by the Parking Authority Board.** The city, to provide for economic growth and development, recruits businesses and other entities to the city. The Parking Authority at no time shall engage in economic development recruitment on its own or without first consultation with the city through the City Manager.

Section 2

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
